**Khalil Ahmed (5813)**, Additional Secretary to the People's Republic of Bangladesh has been serving Rural Development Academy (RDA), Bogura as Director General since 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020. Prior to joining Rural Development Academy, Bogura, he served as an Additional Secretary of Statistics and Informatics Division, Ministry of Planning.

Khalil Ahmed is a civil servant and a proud member of the 11<sup>th</sup> Batch of the BCS (Administration) Cadre. Starting his career in 1993, he held several important positions in central and field administration of the Government of Bangladesh. He served at Jamalpur DC office as Assistant Commissioner and Magistrate, at Cumilla DC Office as Senior Assistant Commissioner and first class magistrate, Assistant Commissioner (Land) in Dewanganj Upazila and Bhaluka Upazila, Upazila Magistrate in Banshkhali Upazila, and Upazila Nirbahi Officer in Sirajganj Sadar.

In central administration, he served Finance Division, Ministry of Finance as Senior Assistant Secretary and Deputy Secretary; Deepening MTBF and Strengthening Financial Accountability Project as National Consultant; Ministry of Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment as Deputy Secretary; Local Government Division as Deputy Secretary; Insurance Development and Regulatory Authority (IDRA) of Financial Institution Division as Executive Director (Joint Secretary);

He was awarded National Integrity Strategy (NIS) from IDRA as „Best Officer“ for the year 2017-18 and as “Best Organization Head” under Rural Development and Cooperative Division for the year 2021-22.

While working in the Finance Division, he compiled the e-Book for the first time containing of ten chapters based on all the acts, ordinances, rules, orders, and circulars issued by the Finance Division. The e-Book has been published on the website of the Finance Division in 2012. During his tenure as Executive Director of the IDRA, he compiled three policy guiding books for the insurance industry in Bangladesh and wrote its annual reports for the first time from 2010 to 2018, and published it as a research book.

He completed his BSc (Honors) in Agricultural Economics in 1987 and MSc in Production Economics and Farm Management in 1988 securing First Class 2<sup>nd</sup> position from Bangladesh Agricultural University, Mymensingh. He has the experience to conduct policy discussions on insurance with the stakeholders of this industry in Bangladesh and abroad. He played the role of Chief Advisor of all training programs conducted by RDA, Bogura.

He participated in several international training programs in different countries of the world.
